Geography

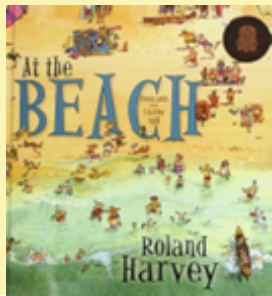
This half term in Geography, we will be looking at features of the seaside and comparing what a beach is like in the UK compared to a beach in a tropical climate.
