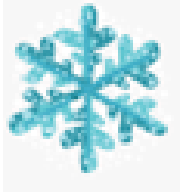




Nursery Newsletter

Maths:

In maths this half term we are going to be focussing on subitising the numbers 3, 4 and 5. We will also be looking at shapes such as triangles, squares, rectangles and pentagons. As well as also continuing our work on AB and ABC patterns which were taught in Autumn 2.

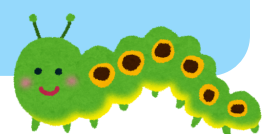


Forest schools:

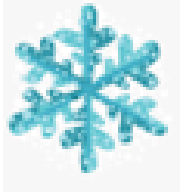
PE:
