### Welcome back to Harpfield Primary Academy!!

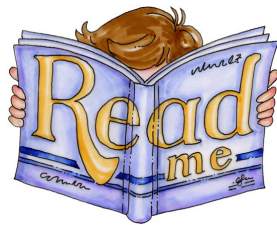

#### Recipe for Success home learning

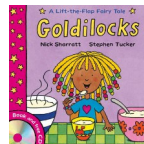

Our Learning themes this half term will be based around the books:

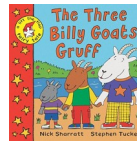
Winnie the Witch

Please remember the Foundation Stage curriculum is an indoor and outdoor learning experience. Ensure your child has weather appropriate clothing and footwear, and a spare change of clothes at school. Don't forget wellies for our forest school days.

#### Forest Schools Friday's

Each Friday every child who wants to will be given the opportunity to join in our exciting 'Forest Schools' activity sessions. Please make sure that your child has wellies in school every Friday so that they can take part. We will be completing activities such as den building, nature watching, digging and mud-pie making.

#### PE

Nursery will have their PE hall slot on a Tuesday morning each week. Please ensure your child has suitable kit in school at all times though. **Earrings must be removed for your child to take part in PE sessions;** if your child cannot remove their own earrings school staff cannot do it for them. This half term in our PE lessons we will be learning lots of new skills in dance, developing our skills of moving to music, moving rhythmically and creating a sequence of movements to repeat in a dance.
