



Year 5 topics for Autumn Term

Welcome to a new term in Year 5.

This term, the class topic is The Anglo-Saxons and The Vikings. The class will be completing various tasks within this topic including carrying out research, finding out about everyday life, creating designs for and learning about the Bayeux Tapestry, drawing and sketching and learning about Viking long ships.

In literacy, the class will be reading *How To Train Your Dragon*. They will think about describing a setting for a story, how to write a list of instructions and an explanation text. They will be thinking about using improved sentences in their independent writing and developing spelling knowledge.

In maths, the class will be learning about the value of each digit in numbers up to 1 million and will be rounding numbers to the nearest 10, 100, 1000, 10,000. They will be using written strategies to add and subtract numbers with more than 4 digits and use these strategies to solve mathematical problems.

In science, the class will be learning about different types of forces. They will find out about who Isaac Newton was and what he discovered.

PE will be on Monday afternoons. The class will be asked to come to school wearing their PE kit.

In computing, the class will be using information from the class topic to create a presentation and exploring how to use LEGO to build and program robots.

In RE, the class will be thinking about religious beliefs in God.

In music, the class will be further developing their skills in singing and using percussion instruments.

Homework will be set on class dojo. This will include the optional tasks and weekly spellings. Mymaths activities will also be set on a weekly basis.
