We will be learning about the needs of a plant and how bulbs grow.

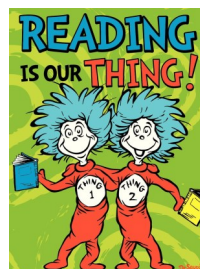
Art
