



Foundation Stage 1 (Nursery) parent information for Autumn 1

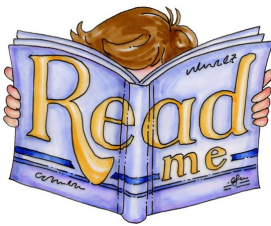
Welcome to Harpfield Primary Academy!

Reading in FS1



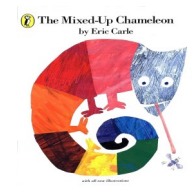
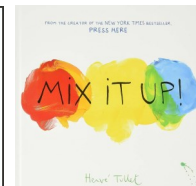
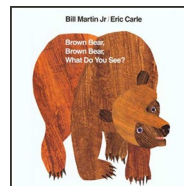
Once the children have settled into our school your child will start to bring home a library book. The library book may be a story or information book and will probably contain words, it would be great if you could share the book with your child and read to them on a regular basis. Please discuss the pictures and ask them lots of questions about what is happening in the book. 10 minutes sharing books daily will have a huge impact on your child's love of reading and future learning. Please write a little comment in your child's diary to let us know when they have read at home. These book bags should come to school with your child with the book and the diary every day please.

Home learning

Once the children have settled in we will also be sending home a homework book each week. Please send the homework books into school on Monday and we will do our best to return these by Wednesday It would be great to see your child's learning and experiences outside of school so please use Evidence Me and/or class dojo to upload photos so we can share these experiences in school.

Forest School Day

Each Thursday every child will be given the opportunity to join in our exciting 'Forest Schools' activity sessions. Please make sure that your child has wellies in school so that they can take part. We will be completing activities such as den building, nature watching, digging and mud-pie making.

PE

Nursery will have their PE hall slot on a Tuesday morning each week. Children will need to come dressed in their PE kits ready on this day. Please wear dark jogging bottoms over the shorts and a school jumper/ cardigan over the light blue t shirt. Children will also need to wear trainers to access outdoors throughout the day.

Earrings must be removed for your child to take part in PE sessions; if your child cannot remove their own earrings school staff cannot do it for them. We would advise no jewellery to be worn to school on any day.

This half term in our PE lessons we will be learning lots of new skills and the basic principles of PE.
