Welcome to Key Stage 2

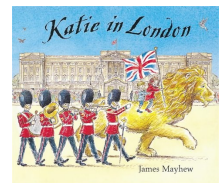


Welcome to the start of a brand new and exciting year in Key Stage 2!

The following learning is planned this term:

Maths: The children will be working on place value and addition/subtraction this half term. They will also develop basic skills weekly and also be learning the 3x and 4x tables. All the children have a log in for Times Tables Rock Stars which is a really fun way to learn their times tables.

Literacy: Children will be learning basic grammar in their writing. They will then write a postcard from the text 'Katie in London' by James Mayhew.



Science: Sources of Light, reflections and shadows.

Geography: London Landmarks; human features/physical features.

Computing: 'Connecting Computers', E-safety/Project Evolve

Music: Paint with sound (trains)

PSHCE: Families and people who care for me/being safe.

Religious Education: Discovery RE

Key Question: How special is Allah to Muslims?

Art: Drawing and Painting looking at the artist: Vincent Van Gogh

German: Learning with Felix and Franzi: Greetings 'Hello, how are you?'
